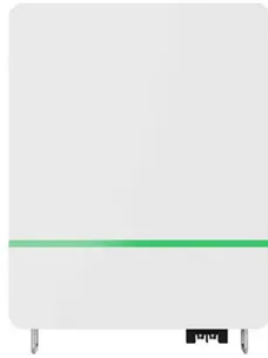

Cold doesn't affect batteries in any lasting way, the cold electrolyte is more viscous and will have a higher resistance. This makes it harder for lithium ions to traverse it thus make the battery less able to provide or accept power. Once the battery warms back up again everything is fine again, no permanent effect.

Are rechargeable AA batteries not as good as non rechargeable?

Use low capacity Ni-MH for low current draw needs like clocks and remotes. They will have lower self-discharge which is an issue with higher capacity Ni-MH. If you have an IKEA, get their 1900mAh LADDA battery, or get Eneloop 1900mAh batteries. Keep the high capacity batteries for high current devices like game controllers or flashlights.

When my company was developing our line I was doing a lot of the long term tests and cycles. It was a small percentage but I found after 4 days of sitting at full charge most decent packs and all cheap ones (we had over 10 from the different factories) started losing voltage at the 4 day mark.

Don't do that immediately. If you EVER leave a battery in the cold, bring it up to room temperature before charging to make your batteries last longer. Cold charges can damage the cells. Lithium batteries are amazing, but the technology isn't where we can just leave and forget it. Also, never leave them on a charger.
