

# Is it okay to install the base station on top of a cabinet



## Overview

Placing your Base Station in a cabinet, closet, or around dense materials (such as granite, concrete, or metal) can weaken its signal to other SimpliSafe devices. I'm looking to build a network/server cabinet - but I'll be building it within in-built cabinetry (around 600mm depth). But this means internal space is actually going to be probably closer to 550mm which means. can I mount a ceiling AP on top of a kitchen cabinet upside down?

I don't want to go into my attic to run a wire but I can easily run a CAT6 up to my upper kitchen cabinets at the top. So ~7 ft off the floor, above the fridge. Would a ceiling AP work right if it's just sitting upside down on top of. And install a radio in. I'd be able to open a drawer or lid to access the radio and mic. When I'm done I can close it and it's out of the way. In such cases, you must use the Antenna Relocation Kit (model 900914), sold separately, which includes a 900 MHz relocation area.
